The Artificial Optical Radiation (AOR) directive was written by the health protection agency for its EU members.

It has in view to guarantee safety to users of those products that emit any form of radiation.

The AOR directive is only meant for products that emit any form of radiation that falls outside of the product and as such can create undesired side effects and / or health & safety risks to persons, who are exposed to this radiation source.

Onto the Aetaire range: the Air 160, Air 200 and Air 300 units

The UV-C light disinfection process in these units takes place in the closed metal disinfection chamber. As no light can come out of this chamber, the Aetaire range does not fall under the AOR directive.

And as such this product group it is not mentioned or listed in the product list of the European AOR Directive.
